

# Formulation of General Rules of the English Pronunciation

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General rules of the English pronunciation are formulated as an endeavour to give a **single English pronunciation** to every word in an English dictionary by applying the **concept of sub-syllables** and **mathematics**. There were remarkable changes with the introduction of IPA in English pronunciation towards the end of 19<sup>th</sup> century and several revisions in 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> centuries which went unnoticed to many of us. Prominently, some phonetic sounds/symbols were newly introduced and some of the old phonetic sounds/symbols were deleted in English pronunciation.

- (I) **Syllabification.** Identify the stressed (primary/secondary) syllable(s) of a multi-syllable word from the left hand side of the word. Make the number of letters of the stressed syllable as many as possible. Do not change/delete the letter(s)/the sound of the letter(s) of the stressed syllable as far as possible. Counting from the left, in case of any change, go for the minimum change. Make the number of syllables of a word as small as possible.
- (II) The letters- a, e, i, o, u, y generally do not take the sound- uh (full schwa)/uh (faint schwa) in the stressed syllable (except in some monosyllables and in the formation of diphthongs and triphthongs). Generally, the letter- a/e/i/o/u/y takes the sound- uh/uh to become unstressed syllable.
- (III) Do not change/delete the letter(s)/the sound of the letter(s) of the unstressed syllable as far as possible. In case of any change, go for the minimum change. Counting from the left hand side, make the number of the letters of the unstressed syllable as many as possible.
- (IV) Generally, every stressed syllable and unstressed syllable is followed by unstressed syllable and stressed syllable respectively. The unstressed syllable can be followed by unstressed or stressed syllable but the stressed syllable is always followed by the unstressed syllable, except in the case of compound words, some interjections and adverbs. The pronunciation of mutli-syllables with more stressed syllables is preffered.

*NOTE : Before syllabification, a learner needs to be thorough with all the possible sounds of every syllable and equivalent sounds of sub-syllables/syllables.*

## (V) Repeataion of alphabet.

- (a) If a letter (consonant) is repeated in a word, then, the pronunciation of the word generally takes the sound of the letter only once and becomes the part of the stressed syllable provided the

repeated letters in the word do not take different sound(s), and that the letter- a/e/i/o/u in the stressed syllable is not generally changed.

(VI) The pronunciation of a word depends on the parts of speech, especially verb, adjective and noun.

A multi-syllable word which has noun, adjective and verb, generally the pronunciation of the word of adjective and noun is same and the pronunciation of the word of verb makes the action/last syllable stressed. In the pronunciation of two syllable words having only noun and verb parts of speech, generally the first syllable is stressed for noun and the last syllable is stressed for verb.

In the pronunciation of two syllable words having only noun and adjective parts of speech, generally the first syllable is stressed for noun and the last syllable is stressed for adjective. Many words (which have only both verb and noun parts of speech) have same pronunciation. In case of a two syllables adverb, the second syllable is stressed (if the first syllable is also stressed, then the first syllable is given secondary stressed and the second syllable is given primary stressed).

(VIII). Most of the English words have different pronunciations due to the difference in accent (British/American). When I looked into the English pronunciation after the introduction of IPA in late 19<sup>th</sup> century and subsequent major revisions, the pronunciation of all English words were grouped in two categories; 1. Single British and American pronunciations (with two alternatives in some British pronunciations) and 2. Common to both British and American pronunciations (with two alternatives in some cases). It is important to note that some single British and American pronunciations have the same pronunciation which is due to the difference of IPA symbols used. The main differences between the British and American English pronunciations are: 1. The choice of phonetic sounds and 2. Syllabification. The variation between the British and American English pronunciations is mainly due to r-controlled vowel sounds and the control of r-sound by vowel sounds in the British pronunciation (with some variations in modern standard dictionaries). The equivalent sounds of sub-syllables/syllables are mainly due to the variation of British and American pronunciations. In this section, the general patterns of the variation of British and American pronunciations are identified which, in fact, make learning English pronunciation much easier.
