

# NEW ENGLISH PRONOUNCING SKILLS PRACTICE FORMAT 1

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## Introduction:

By applying the Concept of Sub-syllables in English Language, a new strategy of learning English pronouncing skills is developed which includes all aspects of English pronunciation and enables to pronounce every word correctly in Cambridge Advanced Learner's Dictionary (4<sup>th</sup> Edition) and Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary (10<sup>th</sup> Edition).

## Concept of Sub-Syllables

A sub-syllable is defined as an alphabet/letter or group of alphabet/letters which forms a part of a syllable (if the word is multi-syllable)/monosyllable. English is a non-phonetic language. However, the possible sounds of every sub-syllable are finite and that the sound of every sub-syllable depends on the parts of speech, structure and origin of a word. The sub-syllables include all the sounds of vowels (monophthong/diphthong/triphthong) and consonants (voiced and voiceless). The **Concept of Sub-Syllables** is a new system for learning English pronunciation efficiently. It has enabled to pronounce every word in an English dictionary correctly and easily, indicates and explains the silence of sounds when pronouncing some words, identifies different words having the same pronunciation and different words with similar pronunciations, has enabled to pin-point the differences between the British and American English pronunciations. It has enabled to explain how the letter-r and l control the vowel sounds and how the vowel sounds control r-sound in British pronunciation. By applying, Mathematics and the Concept of Sub-Syllables, I have formulated the general rules of English pronunciation which give a single pronunciation to every word in an English dictionary without giving any specific preference to British or American accent. If a word has more than one pronunciation, then the preferred pronunciation is underlined. The underlined pronunciation of a word indicates generally the maximum number of correct letters of the spelling of the word. It has paved a new way to non-native speakers to learn English pronouncing skills without strictly following the British or American accent, which can be understood by the native speakers. Significantly, it has enabled to write the spelling of all the IPA/sound of sub-syllables and syllables of foreign origin reflected in English language. The Concept of Sub-Syllables is applicable to any existing language in the world and could herald the beginning of learning foreign languages (including Hindi) in a new way. The applications of the Concept of Sub-Syllables in English language are reflected in this article which covers all general aspects of teaching and learning of the English pronunciation. The main objective of this article is to enable both the students and teachers learn to pronounce all the sounds of IPA and sub-syllables/syllables of foreign origin related to English language correctly and easily.

# **Construction, Spellings and classification of English IPA**

## **(i) Construction of the sounds of English IPA**

- (a) The author's phonetic sounds of vowels are constructed using the letters - a, e, h, i, o, u, w, y.
- (b) There is a major shift in pronouncing English IPA of consonants by applying the concept of sub-syllables (using the sound of faint schwa-uh). The faint schwa is used after a consonant if it is before a vowel sound and before the consonant if it is after a vowel sound.
- c) The sound of [e] (written as e in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a short, close-mid, high-mid and frontal vowel sound (monophthong). The sound of [æ] (written as a in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a short, open-mid, low-mid and frontal vowel sound (monophthong). The sound of [e] is close-mid and that of [ɛ] is open-mid where as the sound of [æ] is produced with mouth open little wider than that of [ɛ]. For simplicity, the phonetic sound (Author's) of [e] and [æ] are pronounced as *auh* (short& high-mid) and *ahuh* (short&low-mid) respectively. The sound of [a:] (written as ah in the spelling) in the spelling of the pronunciation is a long (monophthong), open, low and back vowel sound. The sound of [a:] is pronounced as *ahh* (long & low).
- d) The sound of [i:] (written as ee in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a long (monophthong), close, high and frontal vowel sound. The sound of [ɪ] (written as i in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a short (monophthong), close (open little wider than [i:]), high (pronounce little lower than [i:]) and frontal vowel sound. For simplicity, the phonetic sound (Author's) of [i:] and [ɪ] are pronounced as *ee* (long&high)(which is the primary sound of the vowel - e) and *euh* (short&high) respectively. The sound of [i] (written as i in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a short (monophthong), close, high and frontal vowel sound. For simplicity, the phonetic sound (Author's) of [i] is pronounced as *ehuh* (short &high).
- e) The sound of [ə](full schwa) and [ɔ] (faint schwa) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation are both short, mid and central vowel sound, the only difference is that the sound of [ɔ] is produced little shorter than that of [ə]. For simplicity, the phonetic sound (Author's) of [ə] and [ɔ] are written as *uh* (short&mid) and *uh* (shorter and mid) respectively.
- The sound of [ʌ ](written as u in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a short (monophthong), open-mid, low-mid and near back vowel sound. The sound of [ʌ] is produced with mouth little more open and pronounced little lower than that of [ə]. For simplicity, the phonetic sound (Author's) of [ə] and [ʌ] are pronounced as *uh* (short & mid) and *uhh* (short and mid) respectively. The sound of [ɜ:]/[ɔ:](written as uhhh/ur in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a long(monophthong), open-mid, low-mid and central vowel sound. The sound of [ɜ:]/[ɔ:] is produced with mouth little more open and pronounced little lower than that of [ə]. For simplicity, the phonetic sound (Author's) of [ə] and [ɜ:]/[ɔ:] are pronounced as *uh*(short& mid) and *uhhh/uuhhr* (long and mid) respectively.
- (f) The sound of [ɒ](written as o in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a short (monophthong), open, low and back vowel sound. Using the concept of sub-syllables, the sound is pronounced as *ouh* (short). The sound of [ɔ:](written as aw in the spelling) in the spelling of the

author's pronunciation is a long (monophthong), open-mid, low-mid and back vowel sound. For simplicity, the sound is pronounced as oo (long). The sound of [ɔ] (written as aw in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a short (monophthong), open-mid, low-mid and back vowel sound. For simplicity, the sound is pronounced as oo (short). The sound of [u:](written as oo in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a long (monophthong), close, high and back vowel sound. For simplicity, the sound is pronounced as uhwoo (long and high). The sound of [u](written as uu in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a short (monophthong), close, high and back vowel sound. For simplicity, the sound is pronounced as uhwuu (short and high). The sound of [ʊ](written as uu in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a short (monophthong), close, high and near back vowel sound. For simplicity, the sound is pronounced as uhwuu (short and high). The sound of [əʊ]/[oʊ] (written as oh in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a (diphthong, mid and central vowel sound)/(diphthong, close-mid, high-mid and back vowel sound). For simplicity, the sound is pronounced as uhuhwuu/ouhwuu which is the primary sound of the vowel - o.

- g) The sound of [ɔɪ](written as oi in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a diphthong, open-mid, low-mid and back vowel sound. The sound of [aʊ] (written as ou in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a (diphthong, open, low and frontal vowel sound)/(diphthong, open-mid, low-mid and front vowel sound). For simplicity, the sound of [ɔɪ] and [aʊ] are pronounced as ouhy and ahhuhwuu/ahuhwuu respectively. The sound of [eɪ](written as ay in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a diphthong, close-mid, high-mid and frontal vowel sound. The sound of [aɪ] (written as I/y in the spelling) in the spelling of the author's pronunciation is a diphthong, open, low and frontal vowel sound. The sound of [aɪ] is produced with the mouth more wide open than that of [eɪ]. For simplicity, the sound of [eɪ] and [aɪ] are pronounced as auhy (which is the primary sound of the vowel - a) and ahhuhhy (which is the primary sound of the vowel - i) respectively.

**(ii). English IPA/the spellings of English IPA/the corresponding Author's phonetic symbols in the spellings of pronunciation/classification of vowels &consonants.**

English IPA/The spellings of English IPA/the corresponding Author's phonetic symbols in the spellings of pronunciation/classification of vowels &consonants by applying the Concept of Sub-Syllables. All vowels are voiced whereas some consonants are voiced and other consonants are voiceless.

(d) Most of the vowel phonetic symbols and some of the consonant phonetic symbols (before the introduction of IPA in English pronunciation) are modified which correspond uniquely to the sounds of IPA reflected in English language and are used in the spelling of the pronunciation of words instead of using IPA transcriptions. Two IPA consonants: [t̪] (flap t sound) reflected only in American pronunciation and [x] reflected in foreign origin words are retained in the spelling of the pronunciation of words. - (g) Some words of foreign origin are pronounced in two ways; the first way is from the Oxford Advanced Learner's Dictionary (10<sup>th</sup> Edition) and the second way is from the Cambridge Advanced Learner's Dictionary (4<sup>th</sup> Edition).
